COMPENSATION

REPORTING

The Direct Report will be to the Lead Pastor or if he is unavailable, to the Associate Pastor.

LIFESTYLE and LOCAL CHURCH

Live a life considered worthy of the gospel and endeavor to emulate Jesus Christ. Spend time in the Word and in prayer apart from prep for teaching and this job. Strive to grow as a teacher, a leader, and a disciple of Jesus. Be a good church member, which includes attending church-wide events, a Life or Small Group (when possible), giving, and participating in church as each local church member is called upon to do as outlined in Scripture.

GENERAL OBJECTIVES

- Love the students with Christlike love and teach them the Scriptures.
- Strive to nurture teenagers' hearts towards a growing relationship with Christ (this includes praying for them).
- Engage and equip the parents to shepherd their kids spiritually and provide resources for Godly parenting.
